Arrival and departure

Arrival at male international airport

Once the boarder control done, pick up your luggage and get out of the terminal. Our crew is waiting for you with a board. He will take you to the **Princess Haleema** where everything is set for you. The diving or snorkeling activities will start the next day.

Last day in Male :

The cruise will stop on the very last day in the morning. In case of late international flight, please refer to your cruise director on the different options you have to **spend the day in the capital city**.

If you have a domestic flight:

- Boarding pass of the previous international flight mandatory • Luggage max. 25 kilos for divers. Extra kilo US\$2
- Hand luggage 8 kilos.

Good to know :

- **No mandatory vaccine** for the Maldives. Please check with your family doctor for more informations.
- Your passport must be valid for **6 month after your return flight**.
- Visa will be given upon arrival.
- **Green tax** per person : US\$42 per trip.
- Normal tips for boat crew : 60€.
- Shopping on board must be paid directly cash (euro/USD) or by credit card (Visa/Mastercard).

Eats and drinks

- Full board (international and local cuisine)
- Eat inside or outside on the back deck
- Tea, coffee, drinking water included
- Snacks in the afternoon
- **Drinks extras** : sodas, fruit juices, sparkling water, alcoholic beverages. Prices can change at any time : soda 2€, bières 3€, verre de vin/Martini 3,50€, cocktail 8€, Ti punch, Planteur, Cuba libre 4€, bouteille de vin 18€, champagne 70€.

Internet

The boat provides a wireless 4G connexion. You have an acces as long as the signal stays, depending on your route.

Excursions

Some snorkeling sessions will be offered during the trip. Guides will join if available.

Diving

In a nutshell

- 15 dives package included, including 1 night dive
- **No decompression dives / 30m/100ft max.**
- 2 to 3 dives per day
- Aluminium 12L tanks (DIN & Int.) + weights included
- Temperature : water 27°C - 31°C, air 28°C - 34°C

Minimum level required

Due to the **technical difficulty** of some dive sites, we ask for a **CMAS level 2, or a PADI advanced** certification, as well as 50 logged dives.

Diving boat (Dhoni « Iruvai »)

- 19m / 26 divers max.
- Water
- Showers
- Sundeck
- 3 boat crew members • 2 compressors

Documents needed
